NOTICE OF NO ACTION

On November March 2, 2015, a prehearing conference was held in this matter. Student was represented by Gail Hodes, Attorney at Law. Oakland Unified School District was represented by David Mishook, Attorney at Law. At the prehearing conference, the issues for hearing were discussed and clarified. After giving the parties an opportunity to be heard regarding the issues, the undersigned Administrative Law Judge made several orders renumbering and rewording the issues in this matter. The issues for hearing are detailed in the Order Following Prehearing Conference, dated March 3, 2015.

After the prehearing conference on March 2, 2015, Ms. Hodes sent a letter addressed to the undersigned ALJ. Although there is a notation at the bottom of the letter showing “cc: David Mishook”, no proof of service was attached to the letter and there is no indication that this letter was served on Mr. Mishook. The letter references the ALJ’s “recommendations” during the prehearing conference regarding the issues and contains proposed wording for one of the issues in the case.

As the letter is not a motion seeking any specific relief or finding, no action will be taken by the Office of Administrative Hearings. Further, Ms. Hodes shall serve the letter on Mr. Mishook immediately and file the proof of service with OAH promptly.
