ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO
CHANGE HEARING VENUE

On August 21, 2015, the Val Verde Unified School District submitted a request to change the hearing venue from its office to a combination District office and high school, located across the street from its office. District based its motion on its inability to locate an available space at its District's office. On August 25, 2015, Student submitted his non-opposition to District's motion.

The place for conducting a due process hearing must be reasonably convenient to the parents and pupil involved the proceeding. California Education Code section 56505, subdivision (b), directs the place for a due process hearing and provides that the "hearing shall be held at a time and place reasonably convenient to the parent or guardian and the pupil."

Here, District's requested hearing venue, located at **Val Verde High School, Room 504, 972 West Morgan Street, Perris, CA 92571**, is reasonably convenient to Parents and the witnesses in this matter. Therefore, District's request for the change in hearing venue is granted.
