Subject: Hybrid Electric High Occupancy Vehicle Lane Access Stickers

Enactment of the 2005 Federal transportation bill allows California to fully implement California Assembly Bill 2628. AB 2628, signed into law on September 23, 2004, allows single-occupant drivers of hybrid electric vehicles (HEVs) to drive in High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes.

Use of the HOV lane requires an identification sticker issued by the California Department of Motor Vehicles.

- If the HEV you drive is owned by the Department Of General Services, Office of Fleet Administration (OFA), HOV decals have been ordered and OFA staff will be contacting you to install the decal on your vehicle.
- For all other agency and department owned HEVs each agency or department must apply for their decals through DMV.
