NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO THE TEXT OF REGULATIONS

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code Section 11346.8(c) and Section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the State Allocation Board (SAB) is providing notice of changes made to Regulation Section 1859.71 of Title 2, California Code of Regulations relating to the Leroy F. Greene School Facilities Act of 1998. Regulation Section 1859.71 references a worksheet that will be utilized to collect school construction cost data in order for the SAB to adjust the new construction per-unhoused-pupil grant amount by up to an additional six percent pursuant to Assembly Bill 127, Chapter 35, Statutes of 2006 (Perata/Nunez) and Education Code Section 17072.11.

The above authorization for a worksheet to determine current school construction costs was adopted by the State Allocation Board on September 27, 2006; no comments were received during the initial 45-day public comment period, which ended on March 12, 2007. The proposed Project Information Worksheet (attached) is sufficiently related to the regulatory text and was adopted by the State Allocation Board on September 26, 2007.

If you have any comments regarding the proposed changes, the Board will accept written comments between October 17, 2007 and November 1, 2007. All written comments must be submitted to the Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on November 1, 2007, and addressed to:
