State Allocation Board Meeting, January 23, 2013

DEFERRED MAINTENANCE PROGRAM FUNDING

PURPOSE OF REPORT

To request the State Allocation Board (Board) apportion funding of \$254.4 million for the Deferred Maintenance Program (DMP) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2011/2012.

DESCRIPTION

The Board apportions funding annually for the DMP. The funding for this program is made available by the following funding sources: the Budget Act, any excess repayments from the former State School Building Aid Program (SSBAP), State School Site Utilization funds, and unallocated DMP funding from the previous year.

This Item is requesting that the Board approve the apportionment of \$254,430,098.00, as shown on Attachment B, in DMP funding to school districts for the FY 2011/2012.

AUTHORITY

BACKGROUND

The DMP provides State funding in arrears to assist school districts with major repair or replacement of existing school building components. The DMP receives its funding annually, with the majority of funding made available through the Budget Act and the Board apportions funding for the DMP each FY after the Budget Act is signed.

In response to the State budget crisis, the Governor and the Legislature adopted various measures to provide districts with flexibility in the use of funds. As approved by the Board, beginning with FY 2008/2009 allocations through 2011/2012, DMP apportionments are to be based on the funding baseline established for the 2008/2009 funding cycle and will be in lieu of traditional allocations based on a specific formula for each FY. Additionally, Chapter 12, Statutes of 2009, (SBX3 4 – Ducheny) and the 2009/2010 Budget Act, Chapter 2, Statutes of 2009 (ABX4 2 – Evans) eliminates the local matching share requirements and allows school districts to use the DMP funding for “any educational purpose” through FY 2011/2012. Both SBX3 4 and ABX4 2 were extended for an additional two years by the 2011/2012 Budget Act, Chapter 33, Statutes of 2011 (SB87 – Leno). While districts may expend their reduced DMP funding for any educational purpose, the law, as amended, does not obligate the State to refund or repay a school district that decides to use the flexibility provision and disburse DMP funds for other educational purposes pursuant to Education Code (EC) Section 42605

STAFF ANALYSIS/STATEMENTS

The Board approved the apportionment of all available DMP funding on April 22, 2009 for the FY 2007/2008 funding cycle. By this action, the Board established a baseline for the relative proportionate funding level for the DMP through the FY 2011/2012. Pursuant to the 2012/2013 Budget Act, this level is extended until the FY 2014/2015.

STAFF COMMENTS (cont.)

The DMP funding available for the FY 2011/2012 is \$254,430,098.00 as detailed below.

Staff will continue to implement the plan put forward by the Board on April 22, 2009 that established a funding baseline for the DMP and ensure that each district receives the same relative proportionate percentage of funding through FY 2014/2015. The calculation includes Extreme Hardship funding for those funding requests approved by the Board on April 22, 2009. The Board approved to fund these Extreme Hardship funding requests at the previously approved funding level over a period of five years. The Board considers these Extreme Hardship projects to be fully funded and will not consider any requests for an increase in funding.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Apportion \$254,430,098 as shown on Attachment B.
2. Direct the State Controller to transfer excess repayments of \$673,606.54 to the Deferred Maintenance Fund pursuant to EC Section 17080.
3. Approve the transfer of the unallocated carryover funds from last year of \$406,727.46 for allocation in the current apportionments.

**CALIFORNIA CODES
EDUCATION CODE
SECTION 42605**

42605. (a) (1) Unless otherwise prohibited under federal law or otherwise specified in subdivision (e), for the 2008-09 fiscal year to the 2014-15 fiscal year, inclusive, recipients of funds from the items listed in paragraph (2) may use funding received, pursuant to subdivision (b), from any of these items listed in paragraph (2) that are contained in an annual Budget Act, for any educational purpose.

(2) Items 6110-104-0001, 6110-105-0001, 6110-108-0001, 6110-122-0001, 6110-124-0001, 6110-137-0001, 6110-144-0001, 6110-150-0001, 6110-151-0001, 6110-156-0001, 6110-181-0001, 6110-188-0001, 6110-189-0001, 6110-190-0001, 6110-193-0001, 6110-195-0001, 6110-198-0001, 6110-204-0001, 6110-208-0001, 6110-209-0001, 6110-211-0001, 6110-227-0001, 6110-228-0001, 6110-232-0001, 6110-240-0001, 6110-242-0001, 6110-243-0001, 6110-244-0001, 6110-245-0001, 6110-246-0001, 6110-247-0001, 6110-248-0001, 6110-260-0001, 6110-265-0001, 6110-266-0001, 6110-267-0001, 6110-268-0001, and 6360-101-0001 of Section 2.00.

(b) (1) For the 2009-10 fiscal year to the 2014-15 fiscal year, inclusive, the Superintendent or other administering state agency, as appropriate, shall apportion from the amounts provided in the annual Budget Act for the items enumerated in paragraph (2) of subdivision (a) an amount to recipients based on the same relative proportion that the recipient received in the 2008-09 fiscal year for the programs funded through the items enumerated in paragraph (2) of subdivision (a).

(2) This section and Section 42 of Chapter 12 of the Third Extraordinary Session of the Statutes of 2009 do not authorize a school district that receives funding on behalf of a charter school pursuant to Sections 47634.1 and 47651 to redirect this funding for another purpose unless otherwise authorized in law or pursuant to an agreement between a charter school and its chartering authority. Notwithstanding paragraph (1), for the 2008-09 fiscal year to the 2014-15 fiscal year, inclusive, a school district that receives funding on behalf of a charter school pursuant to Sections 47634.1 and 47651 shall continue to distribute the funds to those charter schools based on the relative proportion that the school district distributed in the 2007-08 fiscal year, and shall adjust those amounts to reflect changes in charter school attendance in the district. The amounts allocated shall be adjusted for any greater or lesser amount appropriated for the items enumerated in paragraph (2) of subdivision (a). For a charter school that began operation in the 2008-09 fiscal year, if a school district received funding on behalf of that charter school pursuant to Sections 47634.1 and 47651, the school district shall continue to distribute the funds to that charter school based on the relative proportion that the school district distributed in the 2008-09 fiscal year and shall adjust the amount of those funds to reflect changes in charter school attendance in the district. The amounts allocated shall be adjusted for any greater or lesser amount appropriated for the items enumerated in paragraph (2) of subdivision (a).

(3) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), for the 2008-09 fiscal year to the 2014-15 fiscal year, inclusive, the Superintendent shall apportion from the amounts appropriated by Item 6110-211-0001 of Section 2.00 of the annual Budget Act an amount to a charter school in accordance with the per-pupil methodology prescribed in subdivision (c) of Section 47634.1.

(4) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), for the 2008-09 fiscal year to the 2014-15 fiscal year, inclusive, the Superintendent shall apportion from the amounts provided in the annual Budget Act an amount to a school district, charter school, and county office of education based on the same relative proportion that the local educational agency received in the 2007-08 fiscal year for the programs funded through the following items contained in Section 2.00 of the annual Budget Act: 6110-104-0001, 6110-105-0001, 6110-156-0001, 6110-190-0001, Schedule (3) of 6110-193-0001, 6110-198-0001, 6110-232-0001, and Schedule (2) of 6110-240-0001.

(5) For purposes of paragraph (4), if a direct-funded charter school began operation in the 2008-09 fiscal year, the amount that the charter school was entitled to receive from the items enumerated in paragraph (4) for the 2008-09 fiscal year, as certified by the Superintendent in March 2009, is deemed to have been received in the 2007-08 fiscal year.

(c) (1) This section does not obligate the state to refund or repay reductions made pursuant to this section. A decision by a school district to reduce funding pursuant to this section for a state-mandated local program shall constitute a waiver of the subvention of funds that the school district is otherwise entitled to pursuant to Section 6 of Article XIII B of the California Constitution on the amount so reduced.

(2) As a condition of receipt of funds, the governing board of the school district or board of the county office of education, as appropriate, at a regularly scheduled open public hearing shall take testimony from the public, discuss, approve or disapprove the proposed use of funding, and make explicit for each of the budget items in paragraph (2) of subdivision (a) the purposes for which the funds will be used.

(3) Using the Standardized Account Code Structure reporting process, a local educational agency shall report expenditures of funds pursuant to the authority of this section by using the appropriate function codes to indicate the activities for which these funds are expended. The department shall collect and provide this information to the Department of Finance and the appropriate policy and budget committees of the Legislature by April 15, 2010, and annually thereafter on April 15 until, and including, April 15, 2016.

ATTACHMENT A

(d) For the 2008-09 fiscal year to the 2014-15 fiscal year, inclusive, local educational agencies that use the flexibility provision of this section shall be deemed to be in compliance with the program and funding requirements contained in statutory, regulatory, and provisional language, associated with the items enumerated in subdivision (a).

(e) Notwithstanding subdivision (d), the following requirements shall continue to apply:

(1) For Item 6110-105-0001 of Section 2.00 of the annual Budget Act, the amount authorized for flexibility shall exclude the funding provided to fund remedial educational services pursuant to Provision 4. For Item 6110-156-0001 of Section 2.00 of the annual Budget Act, the amount authorized for flexibility shall exclude the funding provided for instruction of CalWORKs-eligible students pursuant to Schedules (2) and (3) and Provisions 2 and 4.

(2) (A) Any instructional materials purchased by a local educational agency shall be the materials adopted by the state board for kindergarten and grades 1 to 8, inclusive, and for grades 9 to 12, inclusive, the materials purchased shall be aligned with state standards as defined by Section 60605, and shall also meet the reporting and sufficiency requirements contained in Section 60119.

(B) For purposes of this section, "sufficiency" means that each pupil has sufficient textbooks and instructional materials in the four core areas as defined by Section 60119 and that all pupils within the local educational agency who are enrolled in the same course shall have identical textbooks and instructional materials, as specified in Section 1240.3.

(3) For Item 6110-195-0001 of Section 2.00 of the annual Budget Act, the item shall exclude moneys that are required to fund awards for teachers that have previously met the requirements necessary to obtain these awards, until the award is paid in full.

(4) For Item 6110-266-0001 of Section 2.00 of the annual Budget Act, a county office of education shall conduct at least one site visit to each of the required school sites pursuant to Section 1240 and shall fulfill all of the duties set forth in Sections 1240 and 44258.9.

(5) For Item 6110-198-0001 of Section 2.00 of the annual Budget Act, a school district or county office of education that operates the child care component of the Cal-SAFE program shall comply with paragraphs (5) and (6) of subdivision (c) of Section 54746.

(f) This section does not invalidate any state law pertaining to teacher credentialing requirements or the functions that require credentials.

CALIFORNIA CODES
EDUCATION CODE
SECTION 17584.1

17584.1. (a) The governing board of a school district shall discuss proposals and plans for expenditure of funds for the deferred maintenance of school district facilities at a regularly scheduled public hearing.

(b) In any fiscal year that the school district does not set aside 0.5 percent of its current-year revenue limit average daily attendance for deferred maintenance, the governing board of a school district shall submit a report to the Legislature by March 1 of that year, with copies to the Superintendent, the state board, the Department of Finance, and the State Allocation Board.

(c) The report required pursuant to subdivision (b) shall include all of the following:

(1) A schedule of the complete school facilities deferred maintenance needs of the school district for the current fiscal year, including a schedule of costs per schoolsite and total costs.

(2) A detailed description of the school district's spending priorities for the current fiscal year and an explanation of why those priorities, or any other considerations, have prevented the school district from setting aside sufficient local funds so as to permit it to fully fund its deferred maintenance program and, if eligible, to participate in the state deferred maintenance funding program as set forth in Section 17584.

(3) An explanation of the manner in which the governing board of a school district plans to meet its current-year facilities deferred maintenance needs without setting aside the funds set forth in Section 17584.

(d) Copies of the report shall be made available at each schoolsite within the school district, and shall be provided to the public upon request.

(e) The purposes of this section are to inform the public regarding the local decision making process relating to the deferred maintenance of school facilities and to provide a foundation for local accountability in that regard.

(f) This section shall become operative on July 1, 2015.

CALIFORNIA CODES
EDUCATION CODE
SECTION 17587

17587. (a) Notwithstanding the limitations of Section 17584, the State Allocation Board may each year reserve an amount not to exceed 10 percent of the funds transferred from any source to the State School Deferred Maintenance Fund for apportionments to school districts, in instances of extreme hardship. The apportionment shall be in addition to the apportionments made pursuant to Section 17584. Not less than one-half of all funds made available by this section shall be apportioned to school districts that had an average daily attendance, excluding summer session attendance, of less than 2,501 during the prior fiscal year.

An extreme hardship shall exist in a school district if the State Allocation Board determines the existence of all of the following:

(1) That the district has deposited in its deferred maintenance fund an amount equal to at least 0.5 percent of the total general funds and adult **education** funds budgeted by the district for the fiscal year, exclusive of any amounts budgeted for capital outlay or debt service.

(2) That the district has a critical project on its five-year plan which, if not completed in one year, could result in serious damage to the remainder of the facility or would result in a serious hazard to the health and safety of the pupils attending the facility.

(3) That the total funds deposited by the district and the state pursuant to Section 17584 are insufficient to complete the project.

(b) If a determination is made that a hardship exists pursuant to subdivision (a), the State Allocation Board may increase the apportionment to a school district by the amount it determines necessary to complete the critical project.

(c) Notwithstanding subdivision (a), in any fiscal year in which the State Allocation Board has apportioned all funding from the State School Deferred Maintenance Fund for which school districts have qualified under Section 17584, the board may apportion any amount remaining in that fund for the purposes of this section.

(d) This section shall become operative on July 1, 2015.

CALIFORNIA CODES
EDUCATION CODE
SECTION 17080

17080. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, whenever moneys transferred to the General Fund each year from (1) moneys deposited in the Public School Building Loan Fund pursuant to Section 15735, and (2) moneys deposited in the State School Building Aid Fund pursuant to Section 16080, are in excess of the amounts required to reimburse the General Fund on account of principal and interest due and payable for that fiscal year on all school building aid bonds outstanding against the state, an amount equal to such excess is appropriated from the General Fund for purposes of the Leroy F. Greene State School Building Lease-Purchase Law of 1976 (Chapter 12 (commencing with Section 17000)) and Section 17584. The Controller shall transfer, as directed by the State Allocation Board, such appropriated amount to the State School Building Lease-Purchase Fund and to the State School Deferred Maintenance Fund, which is hereby established.

(b) In addition to the amount transferred pursuant to subdivision (a), the Controller shall transfer annually from the General Fund to the State School Deferred Maintenance Fund an amount equal to any amount transferred to or deposited in the General Fund as a result of repayment of any loan made by the board pursuant to Section 17005.15.

(c) Notwithstanding Section 13340 of the Government **Code**, the State School Deferred Maintenance Fund is continuously appropriated for the purposes for which it is established.
