ABANDONMENT AND/OR REHABILITATION OF FACILITIES
SEISMIC STRUCTURAL IMPROVEMENTS
HARDSHIP STATUS FOR FUNDING

PURPOSE OF REPORT

To present revised policies for the abandonment and/or rehabilitation, seismic structural improvements and hardship status for certain facilities.

DESCRIPTION

At previous State Allocation Board (SAB) meetings, policies were developed to address the replacement or rehabilitation of inadequate facilities, seismic retrofitting of facilities that needed structural repairs to avert future earthquake damage, and hardship status for funding of projects as a result of life and safety issues. As a result of changes to law and amendments to these policies by the SAB, these policies have become very complicated and difficult to administer. The Office of Public School Construction and the SAB Implementation Committee have revised these policies and agree to the revisions as shown on the attachment.

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt the attached revised policies with an effective date for any project approved by the SAB after June 25, 1997.

BOARD ACTION

In considering this Item, the Board approved the OPSC's recommendation. The Board directed the OPSC and SAB Implementation Committee to develop a policy that would waive funding priorities for a district that clearly could not pay its share of a Priority 1 project.
