**APPLICATION FILING PERIOD:**

**MID FEBRUARY – MARCH 31, 2003**

Assembly Bill 14 creates a pilot program that allocates \$100,000,000 in Proposition 47 funding for the new construction of facilities for charter schools. This program allows charter schools for the first time to access State facility funding directly or through the school district where the charter school is physically located and to acquire a preliminary apportionment.

The Office of Public School Construction (OPSC), California School Finance Authority, California Department of Education, Division of the State Architect, and Department of Toxic Substance Control will be conducting presentations to provide an overview of the new Charter School Facility Program and the application process at various locations throughout the State. School facility individuals that may benefit from the presentation include both charter school and school district personnel. Due to the short time frame for filing an application, interested parties are encouraged to attend one of the following workshops.
