About the Workshops

Proposition 1D Introduction

The recent passage of Proposition 1D provides \$7.329 billion for K–12 educational facilities. This law makes modifications to certain School Facility Program features, adds several new grant programs, and provides funding for existing and new grant programs. The Office of Public School Construction (OPSC), in conjunction with the Division of the State Architect (DSA), the California Department of Education (CDE), and the California School Finance Authority (CSFA), will be conducting workshops designed to inform attendees of the funding provided in Proposition 1D, explain the new grants/programs and changes to the existing programs adopted by the State Allocation Board (SAB) at the September 2006 SAB meeting, and answer questions that attendees may have. The workshops scheduled will include:
