Questions	Answers
What are eligible costs for Fire Sprinklers and Alarms?	<p>It depends on the type of project.</p> <p>For New Construction projects on an existing school campus (campus plans submitted to the Division of the State Architect [DSA] prior to July 1, 2002), the water source for the main fire loop, fire hydrants and fire lanes are eligible. Automatic sprinkler systems including a dedicated water source are ineligible for funding.</p> <p>For New Construction projects on a new school campus (campus plan submitted to DSA after July 1, 2002), the following are eligible: water source, main fire loop, fire hydrants, fire lane, lateral fire sprinkler system piping, post indicator valve and fire department connections to within five feet of the new building.</p> <p>For Modernization projects with the DSA Fire and Life Safety worksheets, the Automatic Detection/Alarm Systems are eligible.</p>
