What is the current lead time for site acquisition funding?	90-120 days per our workload goals for all funding applications.
If the site is district owned and district received the site acquisition grant, can the money be used in construction?	Site Acquisition grant funds can be used to reimburse for the original site purchase.

Site Acquisition Presentation Clarification:

Statement: Signature of the district representative is required on the Preliminary Environmental Assessment (PEA) and the PEA invoices.

Clarification: No signature is required on the documents; PEA must be instructed by the Department of Toxic Substance Control.

Statement: Summary of activity only required for DTSC's with removal action.

Clarification: Summary of activity is required all DTSC costs to clarify what are DTSC and Hazardous Waste allowable costs under the School Facility Program.

Statement: District owned site. The slide did not say, "used for non-school purposes."

Clarification: District owned sites must be used for non-school purposes.
