Through State and local funding the Santa Ana Unified School district was able to revitalize the Edison Elementary School. Modernization and Overcrowding Relief Grant funding were used to help bring the school, originally built in 1937, up to modern standards while maintaining the nostalgic charm.

Project Description:

Modernization

- Modernization of 17 classrooms
- New classrooms, multipurpose room, library, administration, media center, and computer labs
- Components include: acoustical ceilings, new doors, frames and hardware, HVAC equipment, lighting, and fire alarms
- Multipurpose room upgrades include new stage lighting and refinishing of the stage floor



Overcrowding Relief Grant

- Construction of 23 permanent classroom buildings to replace 23 portable classrooms in two two-story classroom buildings, RSP/Speech room, staff restroom, an elevator, and two sets of stairs
- New components include: sewer lines, fire lines, domestic water lines, fire alarms, fire sprinklers, storm drain lines
- New outdoor components include: basketball courts, tether ball courts, parking lot, landscaping, and fencing
