Hill Creek School is located in the Santee School District in San Diego County. This School Facility Program New Construction project consists of ten 6–8 middle school classrooms, a two-story addition, science classrooms, computer lab and physical education locker rooms.



Hill Creek School is one of nine K–8 campuses in the Santee School District. The project adds middle school classrooms as part of an overall school campus renovation that includes modernization, photo-voltaic energy generating shade structures, joint-use facilities for teacher training, library, multipurpose room and a child care program. This addition also creates a middle school facility on campus that provides students their own space.



Hill Creek School's staff, students and parents maintain a focus on learning and on high student achievement. The Hill Creek School has a strong community presence with joint-use turf fields that are occupied constantly with sports and other civic events such as, the American Cancer Society's annual "Relay for Life" and the American Heart Association's "Jump Rope for Heart."
