- CAL FIRE is an emergency response and resource protection department.

- CAL FIRE responds to more than 5,600 wildland fires that burn over 172,000 acres each year.
- We cover the state with 21 operation units, 803 fire stations, and 39 conservation camps.
- Our force consists of over 7,800 employees and over 8,200 volunteers.


