

This list documents State departments eligible to exempt a specific solicitation from the Disabled Veterans Business Enterprise (DVBE) incentive per California Code of Regulations section 1896.99.100(a).

Departments that have met or exceeded the three percent goal for two of the three previous years, as published in the Consolidated Annual Report (CAR) for fiscal year 2013-14, 2014-15, and 2015-16 are eligible to exempt specific solicitations from the DVBE incentive per California Code of Regulations on a case by case basis.

In requesting a solicitation exemption, departments should follow and document their own DVBE Waiver processes in accordance with DVBE Incentive Regulations at : <https://www.documents.dgs.ca.gov/pd/smallbus/DVBEIncentiveReg.pdf> and obtain approval from their highest ranking executive or his/her designee.
