CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL REPORT ON THE PARTICIPATION OF SMALL BUSINESS (SB) AND DISABLED VETERAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DVBE) IN STATE CONTRACTING.

This report on the participation of Small Business (SB)/Microbusiness (MB) and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise (DVBE) in State contracting for Fiscal Year (FY) 2010-11 was prepared pursuant to Public Contract Code (PCC) Section 10111(e) and Section 10111(d). This portion of the Consolidated Annual Report (CAR) provides statistical data on SB/MB and DVBE participation in State contracting.

REPORT OVERVIEW

These Fiscal Year 2010-11 contracting activity consolidation reports on the participation of SB/MB and DVBE businesses in State contracting including Consulting Services, the Infrastructure Bond Acts of 2006, and the SB/DVBE Option. This consolidation also includes Ethnicity, Race and Gender reporting.

The statistical data contained in this report comes directly from individual reporting entity calculations and is subject to revision. Approximately 86 percent of entities required by statute submitted reports compared to 88 percent in FY 2009-10 and 93 percent in FY 2008-09. The decrease in report submissions may be attributed to the second consecutive year of State employee furloughs, unfilled staff vacancies and the elimination of vacant positions.

Mandatory reporting entities awarded a total of \$5.72 billion dollars subject to SB participation for the procurement of goods, services, construction and information technology goods and services. Of this amount, \$1.26 billion was awarded to SB/MB firms or 22.12 percent of total dollars awarded. This marks only the second time in five years that the State has not met or exceeded the established 25% SB contract participation goal.

A total of \$5.64 billion dollars, for the procurement categories identified above, required DVBE participation. Of the \$5.64 billion dollars, \$272 million or 4.82 percent was awarded to DVBEs. This marks the second consecutive year that the State has exceeded the established three (3) percent DVBE goal. It is important to note that SB and DVBE spending totals are not equal because purchasing categories associated with inmates, such as inmate day labor and medical expenses, as reported by the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, are statutorily exempted from DVBE participation.

OVERVIEW OF SB/MB PARTICIPATION

In FY 2010-11, all mandatory reporting entities awarded over \$5.72¹ billion in contracts for the procurement of goods, services, construction, and information technology (IT) goods and services. This is an increase of \$400 million in contract spend from FY 2009-10.

SB/MB firms received over \$1.26 billion of the total dollars awarded. The mandatory contracting participation for SB/MBs was 22.12 percent. The participation rate decreased 2.99 percentage points below the 25.11 percent SB/MB participation for FY 2009-10. A comparison table is provided:

CERTIFIED SB/MB FIRMS BY NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES

In FY 2010-11, the number of certified SB firms decreased from 20,832 to 19,693 a 5.46 percent decrease over the previous year. The number of certified MBs decreased from 18,136 to 17,067 during the same timeframe. The following is a breakdown of certified SB/MB firms by number of employees, which is reported pursuant to PCC 10111.

SB/MB PARTICIPATION DATA

The table below shows SB/MB participation in each contracting activity category as reported to DGS by mandatory reporting entities. Awards to SB/MB for Goods (Non-IT) and IT (Goods & Services) exceed the participation goal of 25 percent. On the contrary, awards to Services (Non-IT) did not achieve the goal by 10.73 percentage points and Construction did not achieve the goal by 0.15 percentage points.

The California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR), the Department of Mental Health (DMH) and the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) had a substantial impact on the mandatory SB/MB participation. While this narrative identifies these three significant entities, SB/MB participation, achieved by all reporting entities, is provided in the following reports.

The CDCR represents 25.62 percent of the State's contract dollars (\$1.46 billion/\$5.72 billion). This represents an increase of 4.38 participation percentage points from FY 2009-10; however the CDCR reported \$263 million awarded to SB/MB with 17.99 percent participation.

The DMH represents 6.5 percent of the State's contract dollars (369 million/ 5.72 billion). This represents a decrease of 0.44 participation percentage points from FY 2009-10. Furthermore, the DMH reported \$59 million awarded to SB/MB with 16.01 percent participation.

The Caltrans represents 22.42 percent of the State's contract dollars (\$1.28 billion/\$5.72 billion). Even though this represents a decrease of 2.95 participation percentage points from FY 2009-10, the Caltrans reported \$338 million awarded to SB/MB with 26.36 percent participation.

OVERVIEW OF DVBE PARTICIPATION

In FY 2010-11, all mandatory reporting entities reported over \$5.64³ billion in contracts for the procurement of goods, services, construction, and information technology (IT) goods and services. This is an increase of almost \$490 million in contract spend from FY 2009-10.

More than \$272 million was awarded to DVBE firms for an overall contracting participation rate of 4.82 percent. This is the highest level of DVBE participation ever reported. This is also the second time in over a decade that the State met the three percent DVBE participation goal. It increased participation by 1.04 percentage points above the 3.78 percentage points achieved in FY 2009-10.

DVBE BY BUSINESS TYPE

At the close of FY 2010-11, there were 1,211 certified DVBEs (140 + 1071 = 1211). Following is a breakdown of the DVBEs by business type and industry. As some DVBEs are active in more than one industry, the firm count by business type is not equal to the total number of firms listed in each industry. Approximately 88 percent (1071/1211) of DVBEs were also certified as small businesses (see chart below).

The CDCR, Caltrans, and DMH had a substantial impact on the Statewide DVBE participation. While this narrative identifies three significant entities, DVBE participation achieved by all reporting entities is provided in the following reports.

The CDCR represents 24.6 percent of the State's contract dollars (\$1.38 billion/\$5.64 billion). The CDCR reported \$69.5 million awarded to DVBE with 5.01 percent participation. This represents an increase of 1.19 percentage points from FY 2009-10.

The Caltrans represents 22.7 percent of the State's contract dollars (\$1.28 billion/\$5.64 billion). The Caltrans reported over \$75 million awarded to DVBE with 5.88 percent participation. This represents an increase of 2.75 percentage points from FY 2009-10.

The DMH represents 6.54 percent of the State's contract dollars (\$369 million/\$5.64 billion). The DMH reported \$2 million awarded to DVBE with 0.70 percent participation. This represents a 0.32 percentage point decrease from FY 2009-10.

CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL REPORT OF CONSULTING SERVICES CONTRACTING ACTIVITY

The Consulting Services Contracting for Fiscal Year (FY) 2010-11 was prepared pursuant to Public Contract Code (PCC) Section 10111.

OVERVIEW OF CONSULTING SERVICES CONTRACTING ACTIVITY

The State Contract Act implemented PCC Section 10111 effective January 1, 2007. This code instructs entities to report all consulting services contracts that are awarded, amended, and completed during the fiscal year. Contracts awarded and amended for consulting services was \$601,967,390 during FY 2010-11. This is a 15.86 percent decrease from the previous fiscal year's total of \$715,427,572. The value of contracts awarded was \$439,580,328; and, the value of contracts amended was \$162,387,062.

This year 2,513 contracts were awarded, 1,458 were amended, and 2,252 were completed. This represents a 1.87 percent decrease in contracts awarded, 6.73 percent increase in contracts amended and a 1.23 percent decrease in contracts completed from the previous year. This information is summarized in the following table:

CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL REPORT ON THE SMALL BUSINESS (SB) AND DISABLED VETERAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DVBE) OPTION IN STATE CONTRACTING

The report activity for the Small Business (SB) and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise (DVBE) Option in State contracting for FY 2010-11 was prepared pursuant to Public Contract Code (PCC) section 10111(e) (7).

OVERVIEW OF SB/DVBE OPTION ACTIVITY

Government Code Sections 14838.5(a) and 14838.7(a) authorize the SB/DVBE Option procurement method. PCC Section 10111 (e) (7) requires departments to report all awarded contracts when using this option. These collective codes require data be captured by total contract dollars and the number of contracts awarded.

State entities may use the SB/DVBE Option by contracting directly with two SB or two DVBE firms for goods, services and information technology after obtaining price quotes from at least two such firms. This option applies for contracts greater than \$5,000 and less than \$250,000, and up to \$270,000 for public works contracts.

SB/DVBE OPTION ACTIVITY DATA

Not all entities have the ability to capture this data. Only 71 percent (75 of 106) of the mandatory reporting entities that did submit a report used the SB/DVBE Option. They reported 12,302 contracts that accounted for \$263,301,124. This is an increase from 9,899 contracts and \$187,231,012 reported for FY 2009-10. The voluntary reporting state entities reported 895 contracts which accounted for \$40,384,636.

CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL REPORT ON THE PARTICIPATION OF SMALL BUSINESS (SB) AND DISABLED VETERAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DVBE) IN INFRASTRUCTURE BOND ACTS OF 2006

This reports on the participation of Small Business (SB) and Microbusiness (MB) firms in the Infrastructure Bond Acts of 2006 (I-Bond) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2010-11 was prepared pursuant to Government Code 14838.1(f). It provides statistical data on SB/MB and DVBE participation for all contracting activity using the I-Bond funding.

OVERVIEW OF I-BOND REPORT

Government Code Section 14838.1(f) requires entities to report all contracting activity using the Infrastructure Bond (I-Bond) Acts of 2006 funding. Assembly Bill No. 761 encourages the participation of small businesses in the construction of the states infrastructure, as provided in specified I-Bond Acts of 2006.

Each entity, as defined, is to establish a 25 percent small business participation goal in all contracts it financed with the proceeds of the I-Bond Acts of 2006. All upcoming opportunities to bid on contracts for projects funded by the I-Bond Acts of 2006 must be advertised for prospective bidders.

As of August 1, 2009, and annually thereafter, each entity that has awarded contracts financed with proceeds of the I-Bond Acts of 2006, shall report this spending to the Department of General Services (DGS). The DGS will compare the small-business and micro-business participation dollars for I-Bond contracts. State entities that do not meet its I-Bond participation goal must submit a plan of action for achieving its participation goal.

I-BOND ACTIVITY DATA

In FY 2010-11, 105 mandatory reporting entities submitted reports on contracting activity using I-Bond funding. Out of the 105 entities, only eight (7.6 percent) reported using I-Bond funding. \$235,187,266 was spent with \$5,774,947 awarded to DVBE firms with a participation of 2.46 percent. SB/MB firms received \$6,944,370 of the total dollars awarded. The contracting participation for SB/MBs was 2.95 percent.

In addition, voluntary reporting state entities reported \$14,335,444 for I-Bond funds. Only 9 of 42 voluntary entities that submitted a report used I-Bond funding. DVBE firms received \$665,648 with 4.64percent participation. SB/MB firms were awarded \$6,613,380 with 46.13 percent participation.

CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL REPORT ON THE ACTIVITY BY ETHNICITY, RACE AND GENDER IN STATE CONTRACTING

The Ethnicity, Race and Gender (ERG) report for FY 2010-11 was prepared pursuant to Public Contract Code (PCC) Section 10111(f).

OVERVIEW OF ERG REPORT

PCC Section 10111(f) requires entities to report the race, ethnicity, and gender of business owners who voluntarily report this information. The ERG contract spending reflects \$85,336,059 for ethnicity, \$197,112,249 for the race category, whereas the gender category reflects \$195,165,858. Seventy-one mandatory reporting entities or 66 percent that did submit an ERG report had nothing reported; therefore, the collective reports are statistically insignificant. Furthermore, only 107 out of 124 mandatory reporting entities submitted the ERG report.

In addition, only 27 of 70 voluntary reporting entities submitted the ERG report (38.60 percent). The voluntary reporting entities reported \$3,637,565 for ethnicity, \$11,680,710 for race, and \$13,015,722 for the gender category.

ERG ACTIVITY DATA

The Ethnicity, Race, and Gender (ERG) report captures these classifications for the categories of goods, services, and construction. The same contract may be reported in more than one classification. As an example, a business owner may indicate gender classification and also ethnicity or race classifications. The ethnicity/minority classification data is reported as defined in PCC Section 2051(c).

Reporting entities must send a Voluntary Statistical Data Sheet (VSDS) to every business owner who receives a contract. Business owners opt to return data sheets. Awarding departments compile submissions. The DGS compiles statewide submissions which are reflected in this report.

The ERG report does not reflect the overall contracting and purchasing activity. Many VSDS forms are not returned by business owners. As a result, VSDS reporting is based solely on the voluntary responses.
